- 1 Recognizing and commending Makia Metzger on her outstanding public service; and for
- 2 other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, Makia Metzger was born in Freetown, Sierra Leone, and her journey to become
- 4 the first African American woman to hold the esteemed position of Cobb County Solicitor
- 5 General is reflective of her resilience and determination; and
- 6 WHEREAS, her arrival in the United States in the 1990s was a stark departure from the
- 7 war-torn landscape of Sierra Leone, where she sought refuge from a nation embroiled in a
- 8 decade-long conflict; and
- 9 WHEREAS, educated within the Cobb County school system, Makia attended Campbell
- High School in Smyrna and graduated summa cum laude from Georgia State University with
- 11 a Bachelor of Arts in political science; and
- 12 WHEREAS, while attending university, Makia tele-commuted to Atlanta daily and played
- 13 a crucial role in raising her younger brother with her single mother, all of which shaped her
- 14 into a person of immense respect and compassion as well as instilled within her a strong
- work ethic; and

16 WHEREAS, upon obtaining her law degree from the University of Georgia School of Law,

- 17 Makia embarked on a nearly two-decade-long career in public service, serving as a senior
- attorney in both the Fulton Solicitor's Office and the Fulton District Attorney's Office; and
- 19 WHEREAS, her historic victory in the 2022 election marked her as the first African
- 20 American woman to hold the seat of Cobb County Solicitor General, and in recognition of
- 21 the weight of this responsibility, she pledged to uphold principles of fairness, equality, and
- 22 justice for all; and
- 23 WHEREAS, since assuming office, Solicitor General Metzger has made many transformative
- 24 changes, increasing office diversity from 2 to 25 percent, fostering an environment that truly
- 25 represents the county's demographics, and resolving over 1,000 bench warrants to ensure the
- 26 avoidance of unnecessary and unpleasant police-citizen encounters on the county's roadways;
- 27 and
- 28 WHEREAS, innovative and forward-thinking, she has implemented technology and systems
- 29 to reduce costs and promote digital and paperless prosecution, provided her investigators
- 30 with necessary safety gear, and offered free training sessions for law enforcement and
- 31 attorneys to enhance their professional skills; and
- 32 WHEREAS, Solicitor General Metzger has further dedicated her time and energy to local
- 33 organizations that provide immediate relief to Cobb County's victims and citizens, helping
- 34 them to run book drives and distribute food and clothing; and
- 35 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
- 36 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
