A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of Mrs. Doris Greene Mullis and dedicating an intersection
2 in her memory; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest citizens with the passing of Mrs. Doris
4 Greene Mullis; and

5 WHEREAS, Mrs. Mullis was born in LaFayette, Georgia, the beloved daughter of Reverend
6 Gordon Lee and Eunice Graham Greene; and

7 WHEREAS, a lifelong resident of Walker County, Mrs. Mullis worked at Crystal Springs
8 mill and inspired future leaders as a teacher at Osburn Elementary and substitute teacher for
9 Chickamauga City Schools; and

10 WHEREAS, Mrs. Mullis devoted her time, talent, and energy for over 30 years to serving
11 those with developmental disabilities as a case manager with Lookout Mountain Community
12 Services; and

13 WHEREAS, a woman of deep and abiding faith, Mrs. Mullis was an active and devoted
14 member of First Baptist Church of Chickamauga; and

15 WHEREAS, her leadership and guidance were invaluable to numerous organizations,
16 including the Cherokee Library Board, Chickamauga Public Schools Parent Teacher
17 Association, and Chickamauga American Legion Ladies Auxiliary; and

18 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
19 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example she made of her life,
20 she made this world a better place in which to live; and

21 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
22 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating an intersection in her memory.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
24 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the intersection of U.S. 27 and Pearl Drive in Walker
25 County is dedicated as the Doris Greene Mullis Memorial Intersection.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
27 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Doris Greene Mullis
28 Memorial Intersection.

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
30 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the family of
31 Mrs. Doris Greene Mullis and the Department of Transportation.
