A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Lady Antebellum on its induction into the Georgia Music Hall of Fame; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Lady Antebellum is a seven-time Grammy Award winning trio that has
4 received rave reviews; their new single called "Bartender" is quickly climbing the radio
5 charts as one of their fastest charting singles ever; and

6 WHEREAS, Lady Antebellum has sold over 11 million albums worldwide, eight of their
7 singles have reached number one on the country radio charts, and they have had five
8 Platinum singles; and

9 WHEREAS, Lady Antebellum has won the "Vocal Group of the Year" honor from both the
10 Country Music Association and from the Academy of Country Music Awards three years in
11 a row; they have also won dozens of other awards, including "Favorite Country Group" by
12 the People's Choice Awards, American Music Awards, Teen Choice Awards, Kids Choice
13 Awards, Billboard Music Awards, and the all-genre Grammy Awards for "Record of the
14 Year" and "Song of the Year"; and

15 WHEREAS, the band recently set up the multi-level LadyAID as a philanthropic effort
16 created to bring awareness to and generate support for children in need locally, nationally,
17 and globally; and

18 WHEREAS, Lady Antebellum has inducted into the Georgia Music Hall of Fame, and it is
19 both fitting and proper that the members of this body recognize this trio's contribution to
20 music and the musical history of our great State of Georgia.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
22 commend Lady Antebellum on its induction into the Georgia Music Hall of Fame and greatly

23 anticipates this group's work being recognized and recorded into Georgia's musical history
24 and legacy.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
26 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to Lady Antebellum.
