## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commemorating the centennial anniversary of the City of Cobbtown, Georgia; and for other
- 2 purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the Cobbtown area was known as Quince, named after the post office in the
- 4 area; and
- 5 WHEREAS, in 1905 the General Assembly issued a charter to the Town of Cobbtown; and
- 6 WHEREAS, in 1919 the charter for the Town of Cobbtown was repealed and a new charter
- 7 for the City of Cobbtown was issued by the General Assembly; and
- 8 WHEREAS, transformational events and factors helped shape the prosperity of the city over
- 9 the past century and established a community known for its spirit of togetherness and for
- 10 pulling together to accomplish its goals; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Cobbtown is renowned for its tremendous array of Christmas lights and
- 12 displays along the entire length of the community, along the old rail right of way and a
- 13 Christmas parade is held each year in December, the largest Christmas parade in the area;
- 14 and
- 15 WHEREAS, the city's first 100 years are remembered and revered, positioning it for its
- second century of growth, success, and pride.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 18 join the City of Cobbtown in commemorating its centennial anniversary.
- 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 20 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the City of
- 21 Cobbtown.
