A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Jason Bradburn for his service to the State of Georgia and its
2 people; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Jason Bradburn currently serves as sergeant first class (post commander) at Post
4 27-Blue Ride in the Georgia State Patrol. He has served in this position since August 2021;

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Bradburn previously served as both corporal and sergeant at Post
7 9-Marietta and Post-27 Blue Ridge; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Bradburn became a trooper following graduation from the 82nd Trooper
9 School in August 2005 and worked at Post 6-Gainesville and Post-27 Blue Ridge; and

10 WHEREAS, during his career, Mr. Bradburn served as a field training officer and on the
11 GSP Honor Guard; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Bradburn participated in the Police Unity bicycle ride in Washington, D.C.,
13 during National Police Week. He had the honor of escorting family members of fallen
14 officers during the ceremonies; and

15 WHEREAS, Mr. Bradburn has received several awards during his career, including GOHS
16 Appalachian Trail Traffic Enforcement Network Officer of the Year, Cherokee County
17 MADD Officer of the Year, and Blue Ridge Lions Club Officer of the Year.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 recognize and commend Jason Bradburn for his dedication to the people of the State of
20 Georgia.
