- 8 reduce hours of operations and approximately 37 percent of restaurants to close on days they
- 9 normally operated; and

- advocacy, education, and awareness for the restaurant industry throughout the state to
- 12 express to residents and visitors the great value, quality, and services provided by local food

- 20 industry to provide the highest quality food and drinks in Georgia, to promote small business,
- 21 and to contribute billions of dollars to local and state tax revenue to stimulate economic
- 22 growth are worthy of recognition.
