A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Morehouse College for its many contributions to Georgia and
- 2 American history and celebrating its 155th anniversary; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, Atlanta Baptist College was founded in 1867 in Augusta, Georgia, by William
- 4 Jefferson White to create educational opportunities for Black Americans following their
- 5 emancipation; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Atlanta Baptist College was renamed Morehouse College after Henry Lyman
- 7 Morehouse in 1913, whose deep support ensured the college's success for generations to
- 8 come; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Morehouse partnered with Clark College and Spelman College in 1929 to form
- 10 the Atlanta University Center, which still stands as one of the most influential clusters of
- 11 HBCUs today; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Benjamin E. Mays served as president of Morehouse from 1940 to 1967 and
- mentored many of America's civil rights and political leaders, including Morehouse students
- 14 Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., Julian Bond, and former Atlanta Mayor Maynard Jackson; and

15 WHEREAS, in 2022, Morehouse announced the establishment of the Black Men's Research

- 16 Institute, which will focus on the cultural, economic, personal, and social outcomes of issues
- 17 affecting Black men; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Morehouse has been home to 11 Fulbright Scholars, five Rhodes Scholars, and
- 19 five Marshall Scholars; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Morehouse Men includes distinguished alumni in every sector of American life,
- 21 from business to politics to entertainment to academia; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Morehouse has spent 155 years in service of its mission to develop men with
- 23 disciplined minds who will lead lives of leadership and service; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Morehouse continues to shape the fabric of the City of Atlanta, the State of
- 25 Georgia, and the world by graduating leaders who are committed to community, integrity,
- 26 honesty, and compassion.
- 27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 28 recognize and commend Morehouse College for its many contributions to Georgia and
- 29 American history and celebrate the grand occasion of its 155th anniversary.
- 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 31 to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to Morehouse
- 32 College.
