- 1 Recognizing February 7, 2018, as National Girls and Women in Sports Day at the state
- 2 capitol; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the NGWSD Coalition joins together to celebrate National Girls and Women
- 4 in Sports Day in Washington, D.C., and in communities across the nation; and
- 5 WHEREAS, this day exists in order to acknowledge the past and recognize current sports
- 6 achievements, the positive influence of sports participation, and the continuing struggle for
- 7 equality and access for women in sports; and
- 8 WHEREAS, National Girls and Women in Sports Day began in 1987 as a day to remember
- 9 Olympic volleyball player, Flo Hyman, for her athletic achievements and commitment to
- 10 ensuring equality for women's sports; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the history of girls and women in sports is rich and long, yet there has been little
- 12 national recognition of the significance of girls' and women's athletic achievements; and
- WHEREAS, girls' and women's athletics, at all levels, is one of the most effective avenues
- 14 available through which girls and women in the United States may develop self-discipline,
- 15 initiative, confidence, and leadership skills, regardless of background; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the bonds built between girls and women through athletics help to break down
- 17 the social barriers of racism and prejudice; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the communication and cooperation skills learned through girls' and women's'
- 19 athletics play a key role in an athlete's contributions to her home, work, and society; and
- 20 WHEREAS, a need for increased opportunities exists for girls to participate in and pursue
- 21 physical activity at the community and scholastic levels in order to increase their health and

well-being on a daily basis so that they are able to develop lifelong fitness habits at an early
