- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
- 3 with the passing of Preston Raymond Twyman Jr. on December 16, 2019; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he was born on September 27, 1933, to Marion and Preston Raymond Twyman
- 5 Sr. in New York; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United
- 7 States Air Force, valiantly and courageously protecting his fellow Americans; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he would continue to serve under the federal government after his service by
- 9 working as an EEOC officer and then as an air traffic controller for the FAA, where he

- on the city council and, after retiring, acquired his real estate and brokerage license to open

- 16 Moorish history, reading, research, writing, jazz, and politics; and
- 17 WHEREAS, he was a witness to major historical developments for Georgia, the United
- 18 States, and the world, living through multiple presidents, the Second World War, the Cold
- 19 War, and the civil rights movement; and
- 20 WHEREAS, he spent years of his professional life traveling and relocating all across the
- 21 continent before retiring to Hampton, Georgia, during the 1980s; and
