A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February as Career and Technical Education Month and February 17, 2016, as
2 Georgia Career and Technical Student Organizations Day at the state capitol; and for other
3 purposes.

4 WHEREAS, Georgia's Career and Technical Student Organizations, CTI, DECA, FBLA,
5 FCCLA, FFA, HOSA, SkillsUSA, and TSA, and career, technical, and agricultural education
6 provide a solid establishment for the youth of America and the future of the business and
7 economic development of our state; and

8 WHEREAS, these organizations promote occupational excellence, leadership, and
9 citizenship among their members who are preparing for the work force and further education;
10 and

11 WHEREAS, Georgia's Career and Technical Student Organizations are an integral and
12 co-curricular component of career, technical, and agricultural education programs, which are
13 designed to support instructional objectives and attainment of academic and technical
14 competencies; and

15 WHEREAS, they provide an opportunity for students to gain confidence and knowledge
16 through competition and motivate youth to become better students and more productive
17 citizens who, in turn, develop into school and community leaders; and

18 WHEREAS, February is officially recognized as Career and Technical Education Month by
19 the Association for Career and Technical Education and the Georgia Association for Career
20 and Technical Education.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
22 recognize February as Career and Technical Education Month and February 17, 2016, as
23 Georgia Career and Technical Student Organizations Day at the state capitol.
