A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Charles Glover Spencer; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Charles Glover Spencer has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the most
3 distinguished rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
5 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques
6 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and
- 7 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and
8 Charles has ably evidenced his aptitude and competency in mastering the various special
9 skills taught through the Boy Scout program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, this hard-working young man is a member of Troop 1101, Dragon Patrol, and
11 has demonstrated great leadership skills and initiative during his years with the Boy Scout
12 program; and
- 13 WHEREAS, this is only the third time in the history of Troop 1101 that 100 percent of all
14 the boys in the patrol have received their Eagle rank together; and
- 15 WHEREAS, as his Eagle Scout project, Charles tore down a degrading outdoor stairway and
16 replaced it with a permanent stone set leading to a renovated fire pit surrounded by new
17 benches; and
- 18 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Charles Glover Spencer has truly exhibited a
19 commitment to the scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently
20 conducted himself in a manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and

21 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
22 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
24 commend Charles Glover Spencer for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest
25 honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the
26 prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
