A RESOLUTION

1 Celebrating Diwali; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, for millions of Indian-Americans, Diwali (or Deepavali) is a time for 3 thanksgiving and prayer for health, knowledge, and peace; and

WHEREAS, Diwali, a festival of great significance to Indian-Americans, is celebrated
annually by Hindus, Sikhs, Jains, and others throughout the United States; and

6 WHEREAS, Diwali is a festival of lights that occurs on a moonless night, during which
7 celebrants light small oil lamps; place them around the home; and pray for health,
8 knowledge, and peace; and

9 WHEREAS, celebrants of Diwali believe that the rows of lamps symbolize the light within10 the individual that rids the soul of the darkness of ignorance; and

WHEREAS, Diwali falls on the last day of the last month in the lunar calendar and iscelebrated as a day of thanksgiving and the beginning of the New Year for many Hindus; and

WHEREAS, for Hindus, Diwali is a celebration of the belief that light triumphs overdarkness and that good triumphs over evil; and

WHEREAS, for Sikhs, Diwali is recognized as the day on which the sixth founding Sikhguru, Guru Hargobind, was released from captivity by the Mughal Emperor Jehangir; and

WHEREAS, for Jains, Diwali marks the anniversary of the attainment of Nirvana by LordMahavira, the last of the Tirthankaras (founders of the Jain philosophy); and

WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this holiday be celebrated for itssignificance to the many Indian-Americans who call the State of Georgia their home.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
celebrate Diwali and extend sincere best wishes to the State of Georgia's Indian-American
community for health and prosperity during this special time.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the public and the
press.
