A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Robert "Wayne" Lowe; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
3 with the passing of Robert "Wayne" Lowe on December 15, 2020; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Wayne was born on August 11, 1938, in Eastman, Georgia, a beloved son of
5 Joe B. and Barbara Lowe; and
- 6 WHEREAS, known as the pillar of the Middle Georgia community for more than half a
7 century, he worked tirelessly to improve the quality of life for his fellow citizens and lived
8 by his personal philosophy of "see a need and fill the need"; and
- 9 WHEREAS, for five decades, this distinguished gentleman used his general contractor
10 license to contribute to numerous industries in the area and injected millions of dollars into
11 the economy of his region through his business interests; and
- 12 WHEREAS, in addition to his business ventures, he further served his community as member
13 of the Houston County School Board, the Museum of Aviation Foundation Board, the 21st
14 Century Partnership Board, and others; and

15 WHEREAS, the R. Wayne Lowe Synergy Innovation Complex was constructed in his honor
16 through a partnership of the Houston County Board of Commissioners, the Houston County
17 Development Authority, the Houston County Board of Education, and the Warner
18 Robins-Air Logistics Complex, adding at least 150 new employees to the local workforce;

20 WHEREAS, he was blessed with three remarkable children, Cynthia, Randall, and Deborah;
21 seven wonderful grandchildren, Tiffanie, Brittanie, Jeremy, Erik, Kaelyn, Robert, and Jacob;
22 and one incredible great-grandson, Axl; and

23 WHEREAS, Wayne gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep
24 concern for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he
25 demonstrated to his family and friends were admired by others; and

26 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
27 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he
28 made this world a better place in which to live; and

29 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Wayne will long be remembered for his
30 love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who had the great
31 fortune of knowing him.

32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
33 join in honoring the life and memory of Robert "Wayne" Lowe and express their deepest and
34 most sincere regret at his passing.
