1 Honoring the life of Mr. Ben Napier and dedicating an intersection in his memory; and for

- 9 department, where he helped establish the Stocking Full of Love program and was honored
- 10 with a Jefferson Award for his hours of volunteer service; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage for 58 wonderful years to his wife, Darline,
- 12 and was blessed with an amazing daughter, Kim; and
