A RESOLUTION

1 Commending and recognizing Bonnie J. Hopkins; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Bonnie J. Hopkins has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for the
3 vital role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal commitment to the welfare
4 of the citizens of Georgia and has thus been named one of the Career Women's Network of
5 Macon Women of Achievement for 2014; and

7 including Duke Children's Classic and Children's Miracle Network Telethon, Duke

17 degree in human relations with a concentration in youth agency administration and
18 sociology, and she went on to earn a master's degree in public administration from Georgia
19 College and State University; and

20 WHEREAS, Bonnie J. Hopkins is a mother of two and grandmother of four, and in her free
21 time, she has traveled to India and Zambia on mission trips; and

22 WHEREAS, she is an outstanding individual and an inspiration to women, and it is
23 abundantly fitting and proper that she be appropriately recognized.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
25 commend Bonnie J. Hopkins for being named one of the Career Women's Network of Macon
