8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

9 SECTION 1. That Title 37, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended 10 by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW CHAPTER</u>, to be known and designated as Chap-11 ter 35, Title 37, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

12 CHAPTER 35
13 IDAHO DIETARY SUPPLEMENT ACT

37-3501. SHORT TITLE. This chapter shall be known and may be cited as the "Idaho Dietary Supplement Act."

- 37-3502. LEGAL STATUS OF DIETARY SUPPLEMENTS IN IDAHO. (1) The production, marketing, distribution, sale, and use of dietary supplements shall be legal in the state of Idaho in compliance with applicable federal law and regulations as of July 1, 2022, notwithstanding any amendment, repeal, or addition made to federal law or regulations applicable to dietary supplements subsequent to July 1, 2022.
- (2) For purposes of this section, "dietary supplement" shall have the same meaning as provided in the dietary supplement health and education act of 1994, P.L. 103-417.

SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2023.
