2	RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION; AMENDING CHAPTER 4, TITLE 49, IDAHO
3	CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 49-402F, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE
4	FOR REDUCED REGISTRATION FEES FOR CERTAIN ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY MEMBERS.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 4, Title 49, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 49-402F, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

- 49-402F. REDUCED ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEES -- ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY MEMBERS STATIONED OUTSIDE OF IDAHO. (1) The applicable annual registration fee provided for pursuant to section 49-402, Idaho Code, shall be reduced by half for one (1) vehicle owned by an active duty military member who is stationed outside of Idaho at the time of registration renewal.
- (2) An active duty military member who is stationed outside of Idaho after registering a vehicle under section 49-402 or 49-402B, Idaho Code, may request retroactive application of the fee reduction provided for in subsection (1) of this section in the form of a refund. Such refund shall be calculated on a prorated basis, taking into account the number of months that the active duty military member is stationed outside of Idaho during the registration period at issue. The department shall establish an application process for such refunds.
 - (3) To qualify for a fee reduction under this section, a person must:
 - (a) Maintain an Idaho vehicle title for the vehicle that will have a discounted registration;
 - (b) Provide proof of Idaho residency in a form acceptable to the department, such as a current Idaho driver's license or a pay and earnings statement showing that Idaho is the person's home state; and
 - (c) Provide proof of deployment in a form acceptable to the department, such as a copy of active duty military orders showing that the military member has been assigned outside of Idaho.
