AN ACT

1 APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION FOR THE IDAHO STATE
2 CAPITOL COMMISSION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014; MAKING AN ENDING BALANCE CASH
3 TRANSFER; TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE CAPITOL PERMANENT ENDOWMENT
4 FUND; AND EXEMPTING APPROPRIATION OBJECT TRANSFER LIMITATIONS.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Adminis-
8 tration for the Idaho State Capitol Commission, the following amounts to be
9 expended for the designated expense classes, from the listed funds for the
10 period July 1, 2013, through June 30, 2014:

17 SECTION 2. ENDING BALANCE TRANSFER. The cash balance remaining in the
18 Capitol Endowment Income Fund on June 30, 2013, shall be transferred to the
19 Capitol Commission Operating Fund on July 1, 2013, or as soon after as prac-
20 ticable by the State Controller.
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22 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated and the Endowment Fund Invest-
23 ment Board shall transfer \$1,000,000 from the Capitol Permanent Endowment
24 Fund to the Capitol Maintenance Reserve Fund on July 1, 2013, or as soon
25 thereafter as practicable.
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27 SECTION 4. EXEMPTIONS FROM OBJECT TRANSFER LIMITATIONS. For fiscal
28 year 2014, the Idaho State Capitol Commission, is hereby exempted from the
29 provisions of Section 67-3511(1) and (3), Idaho Code, allowing unlimited
30 transfers between object codes, for all moneys appropriated to it for the pe-
31 riod July 1, 2013, through June 30, 2014. Legislative appropriations shall
32 not be transferred from one fund to another fund unless expressly approved
33 by the Legislature.
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
