4	WHICH SERVICE OF ORDERS AND NOTICES MAY BE MADE AND WHEN SAID SERVICE IS
5	COMPLETE AND TO PROVIDE FOR ELECTRONIC SERVICE WHERE AGREED TO BY PAR-
6	TIES IN CONTESTED CASES.
7	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
8	SECTION 1. That Section 41-212, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
9	amended to read as follows:
10	41-212. ORDERS, NOTICES. (1) Orders and notices of the director shall
11	be effective only when in writing signed by him or by his authority.
12	(2) Every such order shall state its effective date, and shall con-
13	cisely state:
14	(a) Its intent or purpose.
15	(b) The grounds on which based.
16	(c) The provisions of this code pursuant to which action is taken or
17	proposed to be taken; but failure to so designate a particular provision
18	shall not deprive the director of the right to rely thereon.
19	(3) Except as may be provided in this code respecting particular proce-
20	dures, an order or notice may be given by delivery to :
21	(a) Personal service upon the person to be ordered or notified or by;
22	(b) Mmailing it, postage prepaid, by regular United States mail, or by
23	<u>certified mail, return receipt requested,</u> addressed to <u>him the person</u>
24	at his residence or principal place of business as last of record in the
25	department. Notice so mailed shall be deemed to have been given when de-
26	posited in a letter depository of a United States post office; or
27	(c) Where a party has appeared in a contested case or has not yet ap-
28	peared but has consented or agreed in writing to service by facsimile
29	transmission (FAX) or e-mail as an alternative to personal service or
30	service by mail, such orders or notices may be served by FAX or by e-mail
31	in lieu of service by mail or personal service.
32	(4) Service of orders and notices is complete when a copy is person-
33	ally served upon the person to be served, or when a copy properly addressed
34	and postage prepaid is deposited in the United States mail or the statehouse
35	<pre>mail, if the person is a state employee or state agency, or when there is an</pre>
36	electronic verification that a FAX or an e-mail has been sent.
