HOUSE BILL NO. 523

BY JUDICIARY, RULES, AND ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO THE JUVENILE CORRECTIONS ACT; AMENDING SECTION 20-507, IDAHO  
2 CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT THE COURT RETAINS JURISDICTION OVER VIOLATIONS OF  
3 PROBATION OR INFORMAL DISPOSITION FILED PRIOR TO A FORMER JUVENILE'S  
4 TWENTY-FIRST BIRTHDAY.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. That Section 20-507, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
8 amended to read as follows:

9 20-507. RETENTION OF JURISDICTION. Jurisdiction obtained by the court  
10 in the case of a juvenile shall be retained by it for the purposes of this  
11 act until he becomes twenty-one (21) years of age, unless terminated prior  
12 thereto; provided however, the court retains jurisdiction over violations  
13 of probation or informal disposition filed prior to a former juvenile's  
14 twenty-first birthday. If a juvenile under the jurisdiction of the court  
15 and after attaining eighteen (18) years of age, is charged with a felony,  
16 he shall be treated as any other adult offender. If a person eighteen (18)  
17 years of age or older already under court jurisdiction is convicted of a  
18 felony, that conviction shall terminate the jurisdiction of the court,  
19 provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall prohibit any court  
20 from proceeding as provided in section 20-508(2), Idaho Code.
