 2 RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE IDAHO STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY; AP-  
 3 PROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE IDAHO STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY FOR FISCAL  
 4 YEAR 2025; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT  
 5 POSITIONS; PROVIDING FOR ACCOUNTABILITY REPORTS; AND DECLARING AN  
 6 EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Idaho State Historical  
 9 Society the following amounts to be expended according to the designated ex-  
 10 pense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2024, through June  
 11 30, 2025:

28 SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519,  
 29 Idaho Code, the Idaho State Historical Society is authorized no more than  
 30 fifty-nine (59.00) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the  
 31 period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025, unless specifically authorized  
 32 by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be noti-  
 33 fied promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

34 SECTION 3. ACCOUNTABILITY REPORTS. Funds specifically identified in  
 35 statute or in an appropriation act as intended for a certain purpose may

1 be used only for that purpose. Funds provided in this act are subject to  
2 accountability reports and management reviews in accordance with Section  
3 67-702, Idaho Code, provided the Legislative Services Office auditor has  
4 sufficient resources to conduct those reports. State agencies that are  
5 authorized to contract for outside audits shall submit those reports to the  
6 Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee when those reports become avail-  
7 able.

8 SECTION 4. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby  
9 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after  
10 July 1, 2024.
