HOUSE BILL NO. 641

BY APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT  
2 PROGRAM/DIVISION OF FACILITIES; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE PUBLIC  
3 SCHOOLS EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT PROGRAM/DIVISION OF FACILITIES FOR FISCAL  
4 YEAR 2015; PROVIDING THE NECESSARY FUNDS FOR THE BOND LEVY EQUALIZA-  
5 TION PROGRAM; LIMITING THE AMOUNT OF FUNDS DISTRIBUTED TO THE GENERAL  
6 FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015; AND TEMPORARILY RELIEVING THE STATE OF  
7 THIRTY-THREE PERCENT OF THE REQUIREMENT TO PROVIDE SCHOOL MAINTENANCE  
8 MATCHING FUNDS.

10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

11 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Public Schools Educa-  
12 tional Support Program/Division of Facilities, the following amount to be  
13 expended from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2014 through June 30,  
14 2015:

17 Bond Levy Equalization Fund	16,262,400
18 School District Building Account	<u>12,570,000</u>

20 SECTION 2. Of the moneys appropriated to the Public Schools Educational  
21 Support Program/Division of Facilities, the amount necessary to fund the  
22 provisions of Section 33-906, Idaho Code, is hereby transferred and appro-  
23 priated to the Bond Levy Equalization Fund.

24 SECTION 3. The provisions of Section 63-2520(4), Idaho Code, notwith-  
25 standing, the amount of revenue distributed to the General Fund shall be  
26 \$3,337,600 for the period July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015.

27 SECTION 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of Sections 33-1018B and  
28 33-1019, Idaho Code, for the period July 1, 2014, through June 30, 2015,  
29 only, the state is hereby temporarily relieved from the requirement to pro-  
30 vide thirty-three percent of its portion of the school maintenance matching  
31 funds normally required by such sections, nor shall school districts be re-  
32 quired to make up such portion that would otherwise be provided by the state.
