HOUSE BILL NO. 669

BY APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE

AN ACT

REDUCING THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LANDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010;  
APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LANDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011;  
LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; EX-  
EMPTING THE FOREST AND FIRE PROTECTION PROGRAM FROM THE OBJECT TRANSFER  
LIMITATION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,  
the appropriation made in Section 1, Chapter 235, Laws of 2009, to the De-  
partment of Lands, is hereby reduced by the following amount for the desig-  
nated programs according to the designated expense classes from the listed  
fund for the period July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2010:

17 SECTION 3. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the Depart-  
18 ment of Lands is authorized no more than two hundred sixty-one and twenty-  
19 nine hundredths (261.29) full-time equivalent positions at any point during  
20 the period July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011, for the programs specified in  
21 Section 2 of this act, unless specifically authorized by the Governor. The  
22 Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any in-  
23 creased positions so authorized.

24 SECTION 4. The Department of Lands is hereby exempted from the object  
25 transfer provisions of Section 67-3511(1) and (3), Idaho Code, for all mon-  
26 eys appropriated for the Forest and Range Fire Protection Program for the pe-  
27 riod July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011.

28 SECTION 5. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby  
29 declared to exist, Section 1 of this act shall be in full force and effect on  
30 and after passage and approval.
