1 AN ACT
 2 RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE OFFICE OF ENERGY AND MINERAL RESOURCES;
 3 APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE OFFICE OF ENERGY AND MINERAL RE-
 4 SOURCES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; DIRECTING STATUTORY COMPLIANCE REGARD-
 5 ING RESILIENT GRID GRANTS; REQUIRING A REPORT ON ENERGY RESILIENCY SUB-
 6 GRANTS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 SECTION 1. In addition to any other appropriation provided by law,
 9 there is hereby appropriated to the Office of Energy and Mineral Resources
 10 the following amounts to be expended according to the designated expense
 11 classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30,
 12 2025:

27 SECTION 2. RESILIENT GRID GRANTS. Of the moneys appropriated in Section
 28 1 of this act from the Federal Grant Fund and in any other appropriation pro-
 29 vided by law for Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act of 2021 for resilient
 30 grid grants, no funds shall be expended for promotion, advertisement, en-
 31 forcement, or adoption of the International Energy Conservation Code beyond
 32 the 2018 energy conservation codes already in effect, pursuant to Section
 33 39-9701, Idaho Code.

34 SECTION 3. ENERGY RESILIENCY SUBGRANT REPORTING. For the moneys
 35 appropriated in Section 1 of this act from the Federal Grant Fund for In-
 36 frastructure Investment and Jobs Act of 2021 subgrants and in any other
 37 appropriation provided by law to the Office of Energy and Mineral Resources

1 from the Miscellaneous Revenue Fund for energy resiliency subgrants, the
2 Office of Energy and Mineral Resources shall provide a written report to
3 the Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee no later than December 1, 2024,
4 detailing the distribution and use of these funds.

5 SECTION 4. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after
7 July 1, 2024.
