A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND DECLARING THAT THE LEGISLATURE SHALL
3 OPPOSE EFFORTS TO REQUIRE, MANDATE, OR FORCE THE IMMUNIZATION, VACCI-
4 NATION, INOCULATION, OR GENETIC MODULATION OF ANY PERSON AGAINST THAT
5 PERSON'S WILL.

6 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 WHEREAS, there is no mandate or mechanism in Idaho law that would permit
8 or justify the forced immunization, vaccination, inoculation, or genetic
9 modulation of any person; and

10 WHEREAS, it is the belief of the Legislature that immunization, vac-
11 cination, inoculation, or genetic modulation of any person against that
12 person's will would violate fundamental human rights and personal liberty
13 as guaranteed by Section 1, Article I, of the Constitution of the State of
14 Idaho; and

15 WHEREAS, in a free society, the integrity of personal liberty should al-
16 ways be protected, even during times of exigency or emergency, such as the
17 ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Ses-
19 sion of the Sixty-sixth Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives and
20 the Senate concurring therein, that it is contrary to the policy of the State
21 of Idaho to require, mandate, or force any person to receive any immuniza-
22 tion, vaccination, inoculation, or genetic modulation against that person's
23 will.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature shall oppose efforts by any
25 person or entity, including the federal government, to require, mandate, or
26 force any person to receive any immunization, vaccination, inoculation, or
27 genetic modulation against that person's will.
