BY JUDICIARY, RULES AND ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF JOINT
RULE 3 OF THE JOINT RULES OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
OF THE STATE OF IDAHO.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

WHEREAS, the House of Representatives and the Senate recognize and respect the significant time and effort expended by the opposite chamber in drafting, refining, researching, considering, debating, and voting on various pieces of legislation; and

WHEREAS, the House of Representatives and the Senate deem it necessary and desirable to amend Joint Rule 3 of the Joint Rules of the Senate and the House of Representatives to create an atmosphere of honor in the Idaho Legislature.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Session of the Sixty-seventh Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives and the Senate concurring therein, that the Joint Rule 3 of the Senate and the House of Representatives shall be amended to read as follows:

JOINT RULE 3

Report of Action Taken and Transmittal of Bills, Joint and Concurrent Resolutions and Memorials. -- (a) When final action shall have been taken on any bill, joint or concurrent resolution or memorial in the house in which it originates, it shall be transmitted to the other house on or before the first order of business of the receiving house on the next succeeding legislative day with an endorsement thereon by the Secretary or Chief Clerk, as the case may be, showing a complete record of all action taken thereon. When final action shall have been taken on any bill, joint or concurrent resolution which has been passed in one house, it shall be returned to the house in which it originated on or before the First Order of Business of the receiving house on the next succeeding legislative day with an endorsement thereon by the Secretary or Chief Clerk, as the case may be, showing a complete record of all action taken thereon.

Hearing Guaranteed on Certain Actions Passed in Other House. -- (b) A bill or joint resolution passed by one house with a floor vote of two-thirds majority or greater shall be guaranteed a hearing in an applicable germane committee in the other house within ten legislative days.
