A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND APPROVING THE RECESS OF THE FIRST
3 REGULAR SESSION OF THE SIXTY-SIXTH IDAHO LEGISLATURE SUBJECT TO THE
4 CALL OF THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE PRESIDENT
5 PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE NO LATER THAN SEPTEMBER 1, 2021, PROVIDING
6 THAT NO UNVOUCHERED OR VOUCHERED EXPENSE ALLOWANCE SHALL BE PAYABLE TO
7 ANY MEMBER OF THE LEGISLATURE FOR THE TIME PERIOD DURING SUCH TEMPORARY
8 ADJOURNMENT WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OR THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE, AND PROVIDING
9 THAT INTERIM COMMITTEES AND WORKING GROUPS ESTABLISHED BY THE IDAHO
10 LEGISLATURE MAY CONTINUE THEIR WORK DURING THE LEGISLATURE'S RECESS.

12 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

13 WHEREAS, the First Regular Session of the Sixty-sixth Idaho Legislature
14 convened on January 11, 2021, and continues in session as of the date of in-
15 troduction of this concurrent resolution; and

16 WHEREAS, Section 9, Article III of the Constitution of the State of
17 Idaho states "neither house shall, without the concurrence of the other,
18 adjourn for more than three days"; and

19 WHEREAS, the members of the First Regular Session of the Sixty-sixth
20 Idaho Legislature desire to recess subject to the call of the Speaker of the
21 House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate no later
22 than September 1, 2021; and

23 WHEREAS, the approved motion by the Citizens' Committee on Legislative
24 Compensation determined that, if the Legislature, by passage of a concur-
25 rent resolution, adjourns to a day certain for more than three days, no
26 unvouchered or vouchered expense allowance shall be payable to any member
27 of the Legislature for the time period during such temporary adjournment
28 without the approval from the Speaker of the House of Representatives or the
29 President Pro Tempore of the Senate; and

30 WHEREAS, interim committees and working groups established by the Idaho
31 Legislature may continue their work during the Legislature's recess.

32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Ses-
33 sion of the Sixty-sixth Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives and
34 the Senate concurring therein, that the First Regular Session of the Sixty-
35 sixth Idaho Legislature shall recess subject to the call of the Speaker of
36 the House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate no
37 later than September 1, 2021.

38 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no unvouchered or vouchered expense al-
39 lowance shall be payable to any member of the Legislature for the time period
40 during such temporary adjournment without the approval of the Speaker of the
41 House of Representatives or the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that interim committees and working groups es-
2 tablished by the Idaho Legislature may continue their work during the Legis-
3 lature's recess.
