## SENATE BILL NO. 1291, As Amended

1 2 3 4 5	AN ACT RELATING TO SCHOLARSHIPS; AMENDING CHAPTER 43, TITLE 33, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 33-4305, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADULT DEGREE COMPLETION SCHOLARSHIP AND RELATED PROVISIONS AND TO REQUIRE THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO PROMULGATE CERTAIN RULES.
6	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
7 8 9	SECTION 1. That Chapter 43, Title 33, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a $\underline{\text{NEW SECTION}}$ , to be known and designated as Section 33-4305, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:
10 11 12	33-4305. ADULT DEGREE COMPLETION SCHOLARSHIP RULEMAKING. (1) The purposes of this section are to:  (a) Increase the number of Idaho citizens who have a postsecondary de-
13 14	gree or credential necessary to meet future workforce needs; (b) Recognize that one (1) of the many challenges adults face as they
15 16 17	return to college is financing their education; (c) Provide access to eligible Idaho postsecondary education through funding to remove financial barriers; and
18 19	<ul><li>(d) Incentivize students to complete a postsecondary education degree or certificate.</li><li>(2) For the purposes of this section:</li></ul>
20 21 22 23	<ul><li>(a) "Adult degree completion scholarship" means the scholarship program described in this section and in the rules promulgated by the state board.</li></ul>
24 25 26	(b) "Educational costs" means the dollar amount determined annually by the state board of education as necessary for student tuition, fees, books and other expenses reasonably related to attendance at an eligi-
27 28 29	ble Idaho postsecondary educational institution.  (c) "Eligible institution" shall be defined in the same manner as provided in section 33-4303(2)(b), Idaho Code.
30 31	<ul><li>(d) "Eligible student" means a student who:</li><li>(i) Is an Idaho resident as defined in section 33-3717B, Idaho</li></ul>
32 33 34	Code; (ii) Is enrolled in or has applied to an eligible institution; (iii) Is a postsecondary undergraduate student who has not previ-
35 36 37	ously completed an undergraduate degree; (iv) Is an undergraduate reentry student who has experienced a gap of three (3) years or more in the pursuit of an undergraduate de-

- (v) Is pursuing a clearly identified career path.
- (e) "State board" means the state board of education.

gree; and

(3) The state board shall promulgate rules to determine student eligibility, academic and financial eligibility, a process for eligible students to apply, amount of awards, how eligible students will be selected and when the awards will be made, as well as other rules necessary for the administration of this section.

- (4) The adult degree completion scholarship award shall not exceed the actual educational costs at the eligible institution that the student attends. The amount of scholarship shall not exceed the educational costs established by the state board.
- (5) Award payments shall be made annually to an eligible institution. In no instance may the entire amount of an award be paid to or on behalf of any student in advance.
- (6) If an eligible student becomes ineligible for a scholarship under the provisions of this chapter, or if a student discontinues attendance before the end of any semester, quarter, term or equivalent covered by the award after receiving payment under this chapter, then the eligible institution shall remit, up to the amount of any payments made under this program, any prorated tuition or fee balances to the state board.
- (7) There is hereby created an account in the state treasury to be designated the adult degree completion scholarship program account.
  - (a) The account shall consist of moneys appropriated to the account by the legislature, moneys contributed to the account from other sources and the earnings on such moneys. The executive director of the state board may receive on behalf of the state board any moneys or real or personal property donated, bequeathed, devised or conditionally granted to the state board of education for purposes of providing funding for such account. Moneys received directly or derived from the sale of such property shall be deposited by the state treasurer in the account.
  - (b) Earnings from moneys in the account or specified gifts shall be distributed annually to the state board to implement the adult degree completion scholarship program.
  - (c) All moneys deposited in the account and earnings on such moneys are hereby perpetually appropriated to the state board for the purpose of implementing the adult degree completion scholarship program. All expenditures from the account shall be paid out in warrants drawn by the state controller upon presentation of the proper vouchers.
  - (d) Pending use, surplus moneys in the account shall be invested by the state treasurer in the same manner as provided in section 67-1210, Idaho Code. Interest earned on the investments shall be returned to the account.
- (8) The effectiveness of the adult degree completion scholarship program will be evaluated by the state board on a regular basis. This evaluation will include annual data collection as well as longer-term evaluations.
