SENATE BILL NO. 1331

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO EDUCATION; AMENDING SECTION 33-1004E, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE PRO-  
2 VISIONS RELATING TO CERTAIN ADJUSTMENTS TO A DISTRICT'S SALARY-BASED  
3 APPORTIONMENT; AND PROVIDING A CONTINGENT SUNSET DATE.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 33-1004E, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
7 amended to read as follows:

8 33-1004E. DISTRICT'S SALARY-BASED APPORTIONMENT. Each district shall  
9 be entitled to a salary-based apportionment calculated as provided in this  
10 section.

11 1. To determine the apportionment for instructional staff, first de-  
12 termine the district average experience and education index by placing all  
13 eligible district certificated instructional employees on the statewide  
14 index provided in section 33-1004A, Idaho Code. The resulting average is the  
15 district index. The district instructional staff index shall be multiplied  
16 by the instructional base salary of \$23,123. The amount so determined shall  
17 be multiplied by the district staff allowance for instructional staff de-  
18 termined as provided in section 33-1004(2), Idaho Code. The instructional  
19 salary allocation shall be further increased by the amount necessary for  
20 each full-time equivalent instructional staff member placed on the experi-  
21 ence and education index to be allocated at least the minimum salary mandated  
22 by this section. Full-time instructional staff salaries shall be determined  
23 from a salary schedule developed by each district and submitted to the state  
24 department of education. No full-time instructional staff member shall be  
25 paid less than \$29,655 for fiscal year 2011, or \$30,000 thereafter. The  
26 resulting amount is the district's salary-based apportionment for instruc-  
27 tional staff. After the base and minimum salaries established pursuant to  
28 this subsection have reached the amounts that were in effect in fiscal year  
29 2009, all further increases to these base and minimum salaries shall be al-  
30 located such that the percentage increase in the minimum salary is one and  
31 one-half (1.5) times the percentage increase in the base salary.

32 2. To determine the apportionment for district administrative staff,  
33 first determine the district average experience and education index by plac-  
34 ing all eligible certificated administrative employees on the statewide in-  
35 dex provided in section 33-1004A, Idaho Code. The resulting average is the  
36 district index. The district administrative staff index shall be multiplied  
37 by the base salary of \$31,833. The amount so determined shall be multiplied  
38 by the district staff allowance for administrative staff determined as pro-  
39 vided in section 33-1004(3), Idaho Code. The resulting amount is the dis-  
40 trict's salary-based apportionment for administrative staff.

41 3. To determine the apportionment for classified staff, multiply  
42 \$18,684 by the district classified staff allowance determined as provided in

1 section 33-1004(4), Idaho Code. The amount so determined is the district's  
2 apportionment for classified staff.

3 4. The district's salary-based apportionment shall be the sum of the  
4 apportionments calculated in subsections 1., 2. and 3., of this section, ad-  
5 justed by the following percentages:

13 plus the benefit apportionment as provided in section 33-1004F, Idaho Code.

14 SECTION 2. If Chapter 247, Laws of 2011, is rejected through voter ref-  
15 erendum in November 2012, the provisions of this act shall be null, void and  
16 of no further force or effect.
