## SENATE BILL NO. 1337, As Amended

## BY STATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

AN ACT

- 2 RELATING TO CAMPAIGN FINANCE; AMENDING SECTION 67-6607, IDAHO CODE, TO RE 3 VISE PROVISIONS REGARDING CAMPAIGN FINANCE REPORTING; AND DECLARING AN
   4 EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 67-6607, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 7 amended to read as follows:

8 67-6607. REPORTS OF CONTRIBUTIONS AND EXPENDITURES BY CANDIDATES AND POLITICAL COMMITTEES. (1) Each candidate or the political treasurer for each 9 candidate, and each political committee or the political treasurer of each 10 political committee, shall file with the secretary of state a statement of 11 all contributions received and all expenditures and encumbrances made by or 12 on behalf of the candidate or political committee, according to the schedule 13 provided in this section. The statement shall itemize each contribution re-14 ceived and each expenditure or encumbrance made during the reporting period 15 and shall include the following: 16

(a) Under contributions, the statement shall include a list of all the
contributions received, including any funds or property of the candidate used to cover expenditures. The statement shall list the full name
and complete address of each person who contributed an aggregate amount
of more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) and the amount contributed by that
person. The statement may list as a single item the total amount of contributions of fifty dollars (\$50.00) or less; and

(b) Under expenditures, the statement shall include the name and ad-24 dress of each person to whom an expenditure or encumbrance was made in 25 the amount of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) or more, and the amount, 26 date, and purpose of each such expenditure. Each expenditure or encum-27 brance in the amount of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) or more shall be 28 evidenced by an invoice, receipt, or canceled check or an accurate copy 29 thereof. Such evidence shall not be filed with the statement but shall 30 be retained by the committee or candidate for a period of one (1) year 31 after the statement has been filed. The statement may list as a single 32 item the total amount of expenditures and encumbrances of less than 33 twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) without showing the exact amount of or re-34 quiring evidence of each such expenditure or encumbrance. Anything of 35 36 value, other than money, paid for or contributed by any person shall be listed both as an expenditure and as a contribution. 37

(2) For the first report under this section, the reporting period shall
 cover the period beginning with the first contribution, expenditure, or en cumbrance through the end of the current reporting period. Each candidate
 and each political committee, or the treasurer for a candidate or political

1 committee or ballot measure, shall file the report described under subsec-2 tion (1) of this section as follows:

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(a) In the year of the election, a monthly report shall be filed for each month of the year. Each report shall be filed by the tenth day of the month following the month being reported; and

6 (b) For the <u>a</u> nonelection year, <u>any candidate who receives contribu-</u> 7 <u>tions or makes expenditures, or both, that together total five hundred</u> 8 <u>dollars (\$500) or more shall file a monthly report by the tenth day of</u> 9 <u>the following month and each month thereafter for the remainder of the</u> 10 <u>nonelection year. All other candidates shall file</u> an annual report cov-11 ering the nonelection year, <u>which</u> shall be filed by January 10 of the 12 following year.

(3) Notwithstanding any other reports required under this section, 13 each candidate and each political committee, or the political treasurer for 14 each candidate and each political committee, shall notify the secretary of 15 16 state of any contribution of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or more. This notification shall be made within forty-eight (48) hours after the receipt 17 of such contribution and shall include the name of the candidate, political 18 committee or measure, the identification of the contributor, and the date of 19 receipt and amount of the contribution. The notification shall be in addi-20 21 tion to the reporting of these contributions in the regular reports.

(4) All reports required pursuant to this section shall be filed online
with the secretary of state, unless a waiver has been provided under section
67-6623, Idaho Code, by no later than midnight on the date the filing is due.

(5) Reports required to be filed under the provisions of this section
shall be filed until the account no longer shows any unexpended balance of
contributions or expenditure deficit.

28 SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
 29 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after
 30 July 1, 2022.
