AN ACT

1 RELATING TO DEVELOPMENT OF THERMAL ENERGY SYSTEMS BY SCHOOL DISTRICTS;
2 AMENDING CHAPTER 6, TITLE 33, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW
3 SECTION 33-604, IDAHO CODE, TO AUTHORIZE SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO DEVELOP,
4 OWN, MAINTAIN, OPERATE AND CONTRACT FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THERMAL
5 HEATING AND COOLING ENERGY GENERATION AND DISTRIBUTION SYSTEMS;
6 AMENDING CHAPTER 6, TITLE 33, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW
7 SECTION 33-605, IDAHO CODE, TO AUTHORIZE SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO SELL
8 THERMAL ENERGY; AND AMENDING SECTION 33-1102, IDAHO CODE, TO AUTHORIZE
9 THE ISSUANCE OF SCHOOL BONDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING THERMAL ENERGY
10 SYSTEMS.

12 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

13 SECTION 1. That Chapter 6, Title 33, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
14 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and
15 designated as Section 33-604, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

16 33-604. RENEWABLE THERMAL ENERGY. The board of trustees of each school
17 district is empowered to establish, create, develop, own, maintain, operate
18 and contract for the establishment, creation, development, ownership,
19 maintenance and operation of thermal heating and cooling energy generation
20 and distribution systems, included hot or chilled water systems, where
21 thermal energy is generated from biomass, geothermal or solar renewable
22 energy.

23 SECTION 2. That Chapter 6, Title 33, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
24 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and
25 designated as Section 33-605, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

26 33-605. SALES OF EXCESS ENERGY. The board of trustees of a school
27 district which operates an energy system as described in section 33-604,
28 Idaho Code, may use, sell or exchange excess thermal hot or chilled water not
29 needed by the school district subject to the following conditions:

30 (1) Revenues from the sale of energy as described in section 33-604,
31 Idaho Code, shall be used for the benefit of the school district.

32 (2) Sale of energy as described in section 33-604, Idaho Code, shall be
33 pursuant to a school district written contract approved by resolution
34 of the board of trustees of the school district.

35 SECTION 3. That Section 33-1102, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
36 amended to read as follows:

37 33-1102. PURPOSES FOR WHICH BONDS MAY BE ISSUED. The purposes for
38 which bonds may be issued shall be: To acquire, purchase or improve a
39 school site or school sites; to build a schoolhouse or schoolhouses or other

1 building or buildings; to demolish or remove school buildings; to add to,
2 remodel or repair any existing building; to furnish and equip any building
3 or buildings, including all lighting, heating, ventilation and sanitation
4 facilities and appliances necessary to maintain and operate the buildings
5 of the district; ~~and~~ to purchase school buses and to acquire, develop or
6 renovate school facilities to establish, create and develop renewable
7 energy systems as described in section 33-604, Idaho Code.
