SENATE BILL NO. 1425

BY FINANCE COMMITTEE

AN ACT

1 APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION FOR THE DIVISION  
2 OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE AL-  
3 LOCATION OF FUNDS FOR SPECIFIC PROJECTS; PROVIDING LEGISLATIVE INTENT  
4 RELATING TO UTILIZATION OF MATCHING FUNDS; EXEMPTING THE APPROPRIATION  
5 FROM THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 36, TITLE 67, IDAHO CODE, AND FROM THE  
6 PROVISIONS OF SECTION 67-3516, IDAHO CODE; AND PROVIDING LEGISLATIVE  
7 INTENT RELATING TO REALLOCATION OF PROJECT SAVINGS.

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

10 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Admin-  
11 istration for the Division of Public Works \$26,320,000 from the Permanent  
12 Building Fund, to be expended for capital outlay, for the period July 1,  
13 2014, through June 30, 2015.

14 SECTION 2. ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR SPECIFIC PROJECTS. Moneys appropri-  
15 ated in Section 1 of this act, or so much thereof as in each case may be neces-  
16 sary, shall be used for the purpose of paying the cost of any land, building,  
17 equipment, or the rebuilding, renovation or repair of buildings, installa-  
18 tions, facilities or structures at the places, institutions and agencies,  
19 or their successors, including those listed in this section. The Permanent  
20 Building Fund Advisory Council is hereby authorized and directed to antici-  
21 pate revenues accruing to the Permanent Building Fund for the purpose of un-  
22 dertaking the construction, renovation, repair and acquisitions therein au-  
23 thorized, without delay, and to determine the priority of construction pur-  
24 suant to which the work hereunder will be undertaken.

8 SECTION 3. UTILIZATION OF MATCHING FUNDS. It is legislative intent that  
9 the moneys appropriated in this act may be made available for matching any  
10 allocation of moneys now in existence or hereafter made available by agen-  
11 cies of the United States and/or private donations; and it is further the ex-  
12 press intention of the Legislature to authorize the Division of Public Works  
13 to expend, for the purpose of paying the cost of any land, building, equip-  
14 ment or the rebuilding, renovation or repair of buildings, moneys appropri-  
15 ated for public works to various agencies as part of the respective agency  
16 operating budgets; provided the express approval by the Permanent Building  
17 Fund Advisory Council is granted to make application for such moneys in each  
18 instance.

19 SECTION 4. EXEMPTION OF APPROPRIATIONS FROM CERTAIN PROVISIONS. All  
20 appropriations made herein shall be exempt from the provisions of Chapter  
21 36, Title 67, Idaho Code, and Section 67-3516, Idaho Code, but shall be  
22 available for expenditure only after allotment in accordance with the other  
23 provisions of Chapter 35, Title 67, Idaho Code, and all appropriations made  
24 hereunder shall be subject to the provisions of Section 67-5711, Idaho Code,  
25 except as otherwise provided herein.

26 SECTION 5. REALLOCATION OF PROJECT SAVINGS. It is the intent of the Leg-  
27 islature that the Division of Public Works have the flexibility to allocate  
28 any savings or unused appropriation from any capital, line-item project to  
29 any other requested and funded fiscal year 2015 capital projects. The re-  
30 allocation of such appropriation must be approved by the Permanent Building  
31 Fund Advisory Council prior to the funds being spent.
