SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 112

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND PROVIDING THAT NO UNVOUCHERED OR  
3 VOUCHERED EXPENSE ALLOWANCE SHALL BE PAYABLE TO ANY MEMBER OF THE LEGIS-  
4 LATURE FOR ANY TIME PERIOD DURING A TEMPORARY ADJOURNMENT FOLLOWING THE  
5 PASSAGE OF THREE DAYS FROM THE DATE OF ADOPTION OF THIS CONCURRENT RESO-  
6 LUTION WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE  
7 OR THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, RESPECTIVELY.

8 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

9 WHEREAS, the First Regular Session of the Sixty-sixth Idaho Legislature  
10 convened on January 11, 2021, and continues in session as of the date of in-  
11 troduction of this concurrent resolution; and

12 WHEREAS, the approved motion by the Citizens' Committee on Legislative  
13 Compensation determined that, if the Legislature, by passage of a concurrent  
14 resolution, adjourns for more than three days, no unvouchered or vouchered  
15 expense allowance shall be payable to any member of the Legislature for the  
16 time period during such temporary adjournment without the approval of the  
17 President Pro Tempore of the Senate or the Speaker of the House of Represen-  
18 tatives, respectively.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Ses-  
20 sion of the Sixty-sixth Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Repre-  
21 sentatives concurring therein, that no unvouchered or vouchered expense al-  
22 lowance shall be payable to any member of the Legislature for any time period  
23 during a temporary adjournment following the passage of three days from the  
24 date of adoption of this concurrent resolution without the approval of the  
25 President Pro Tempore of the Senate or the Speaker of the House of Represen-  
26 tatives, respectively.
