2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE PUB-
3 LIC HEALTH DISTRICTS RELATING TO RULES OF IDAHO PUBLIC HEALTH DISTRICT
4 NO. 1.

5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive
7 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the
8 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with
9 legislative intent; and

10 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that a certain rule of the
11 Public Health Districts relating to Rules of Idaho Public Health District
12 No. 1 is not consistent with legislative intent and should be rejected.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Ses-
14 sion of the Sixtieth Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Repre-
15 sentatives concurring therein, that IDAPA 41.01.01, Rules of Idaho Public
16 Health District No. 1, Section 100, Water Quality Control, Subsection 06.c,
17 the last two sentences, only, a final rule, be, and the same is hereby re-
18 jected and declared null, void and of no force and effect.
