A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING CERTAIN RULES OF THE IDAHO  
3 STATE POLICE RELATING TO RULES OF THE IDAHO PEACE OFFICER STANDARDS AND  
4 TRAINING COUNCIL.

5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive  
7 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the  
8 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-  
9 islative intent; and

10 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that certain rules of the  
11 Idaho State Police relating to Rules of the Idaho Peace Officer Standards and  
12 Training Council are not consistent with legislative intent and should be  
13 rejected.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular  
15 Session of the Sixty-first Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House  
16 of Representatives concurring therein, that IDAPA 11.11.01, Idaho State  
17 Police, Rules of the Idaho Peace Officer Standards and Training Council,  
18 Sections 091 and 092, only, adopted as pending rules under Docket Number  
19 11-1101-1102, be, and the same are hereby rejected and declared null, void  
20 and of no force and effect.
