2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF JOINT
3 RULE 20 OF THE JOINT RULES OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
4 OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, REVISING PROVISIONS RELATING TO TRANSMITTAL OF A
5 JOINT RESOLUTION.

6 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 WHEREAS, the Senate and the House of Representatives deem it necessary
8 and desirable to amend Joint Rule 20 of the Joint Rules of the Senate and the
9 House of Representatives.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Ses-
11 sion of the Sixty-third Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Repre-
12 sentatives concurring therein, that Joint Rule 20 of the Senate and the House
13 of Representatives shall be amended to read as follows:

14 JOINT RULE 20

15 Constitutional Amendments. -- A Joint Resolution proposing an amend-
16 ment to the Constitution of the State of Idaho must be introduced on or before
17 the thirty-sixth day of the Regular Legislative Session and must be trans-
18 mitted from the house of origin to the other house prior to the fifty-fifth
19 day of the Regular Legislative Session; provided however, in the event the
20 fifty-fifth day of the Regular Legislative Session falls on a Saturday or
21 Sunday, such transmittal must be made on or prior to the fifty-seventh day of
22 the Regular Legislative Session. The provisions of this rule may be waived
23 by the presiding officer of either house upon presentment of a signed peti-
24 tion by the majority or minority leadership of the house. Requests for a pro-
25 posed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Idaho shall be in the Of-
26 fice of Legislative Services for drafting at least seven calendar days prior
27 to its intended introduction date.
