A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects hereinafter
6 named, are appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the
7 Department of Human Services for family and community services
8 and related distributive purposes, including such federal funds
9 as are made available by the federal government for the
10 following purposes:

- 11 For grants and administrative expenses
- 12 associated with Supportive Housing Services ..\$25,314,110
- 13 For grants and administrative expenses
- 14 associated with Homeless Youth Services\$11,277,500
- 15 For grants and administrative expenses
- 16 associated with Homelessness Prevention\$10,000,000
- 17 For grants and administrative expenses associated
- 18 with Emergency and Transitional Housing\$51,000,000

19 Section 10. The following named sums, or so much thereof
20 as may be necessary, respectively, for the purposes hereinafter
21 named, are appropriated to the Department of Human Services for
22 Grants-In-Aid and Purchased Care in its various regions

1 pursuant to Sections 3 and 4 of the Community Services Act and
2 the Community Mental Health Act:

3 For grants and administrative expenses
4 associated with Supportive MI Housing\$28,060,180

5 SPECIAL FUNDS

6 The following named amounts, or so much thereof as may be
7 necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes
8 hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Department of
9 Human Services for income assistance and related distributive
10 purposes, including such federal funds as are made available
11 by the federal government for the following purposes:

12 Payable from the Illinois Affordable Housing Trust Fund:
13 For Homeless Youth Services\$1,000,000

14 For grants and administrative expenses
15 associated with Homelessness Prevention\$4,000,000

16 For grants and administrative expenses associated
17 with Emergency and Transitional Housing\$10,383,700

18 Payable from the Health and Human Services Medicaid Trust
19 Fund:

20 For grants for Supportive Housing Services\$3,720,750

21 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
22 2023.
