2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. "An Act making appropriations", Public Act  
5 97-56, is amended by changing Section 5 of Article 12 as  
6 follows:

7 (P.A. 97-56, Article 12, Section 5)

8 Sec. 5. The following named amounts, or so much of those  
9 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
10 and purposes named in this Section, are appropriated to the  
11 Office of the State Treasurer to meet the ordinary and
