22 under the jurisdiction of the Office of the Secretary of State,
23 including sidewalks, terraces, and grounds and all labor,
24 materials, and other costs incidental to the above work:

2 Section 15. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital Development
4 Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for new
5 construction and alterations, and maintenance of the interiors
6 and exteriors of the various buildings and facilities under the
7 jurisdiction of the Office of the Secretary of State.

8 Section 20. The sum of \$1,995,035, or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business
10 on June 30, 2017, from appropriations heretofore made for such
11 purpose in Article 158, Section 15 and Section 20 of Public Act
12 99-0524, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund
13 to the Office of the Secretary of State for new construction
14 and alterations, and maintenance of the interiors and exteriors
15 of the various buildings and facilities under the jurisdiction
16 of the Office of the Secretary of State.

17 Section 25. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as may
18 be necessary, is appropriated from the State Parking Facility
19 Maintenance Fund to the Secretary of State for the maintenance
20 of parking facilities owned or operated by the Secretary of
21 State.

1 Section 30. The following named sums, or so much thereof
 2 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the
 3 Office of the Secretary of State for the following purposes:

3 such purposes, the sum of \$1,288,800, or so much thereof as may
4 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
5 the Office of the Secretary of State for a grant to the Chicago
6 Public Library.

7 Section 85. The sum of \$0, or so much thereof as may be
8 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the
9 Office of the Secretary of State for all expenditures and grants

1 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
2 of State from the Master Mason Fund to provide grants to
3 Illinois Masonic Charities Fund, a not-for-profit corporation,
4 for charitable purposes.

5 Section 105. The sum of \$75,000, or so much thereof as may
6 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
7 the Illinois Pan Hellenic Trust Fund to provide grants for
8 charitable purposes sponsored by African-American fraternities
9 and sororities.

10 Section 110. The sum of \$27,000, or so much thereof as may
11 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
12 the Park District Youth Program Fund to provide grants for the
13 Illinois Association of Park Districts: After School
14 Programming.

15 Section 115. The sum of \$180,000, or so much thereof as may
16 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
17 the Illinois Route 66 Heritage Project Fund to provide grants
18 for the development of tourism, education, preservation and
19 promotion of Route 66.

20 Section 120. The sum of \$180,000, or so much thereof as may
21 be necessary, is appropriated from the Police Memorial

1 Committee Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for
 2 grants to the Police Memorial Committee for maintaining a
 3 memorial statue, holding an annual memorial commemoration, and
 4 giving scholarships to children of police officers killed in
 5 the line of duty.

6 Section 125. The sum of \$130,000, or so much thereof as may
 7 be necessary, is appropriated from the Mammogram Fund to the
 8 Office of the Secretary of State for grants to the Susan G.
 9 Komen Foundation for breast cancer research, education,
 10 screening, and treatment.

11 Section 130. The following named sum, or so much thereof
 12 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the
 13 Office of the Secretary of State for such purposes in Section
 14 3-646 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5), for grants to
 15 the Regional Organ Bank of Illinois and to Mid-America
 16 Transplant Services for the purpose of promotion of organ and
 17 tissue donation awareness. These amounts are in addition to any
 18 amounts otherwise appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
 19 of State:

20 From Organ Donor Awareness Fund160,000

21 Section 135. The sum of \$45,000, or so much thereof as may
 22 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from

1 the Chicago Police Memorial Foundation Fund for grants to the
2 Chicago Police Memorial Foundation for maintenance of a
3 memorial and park, holding an annual memorial commemoration,
4 giving scholarships to children of police officers killed or
5 catastrophically injured in the line of duty, providing
6 financial assistance to police officers and their families when
7 a police officer is killed or injured in the line of duty, and
8 paying the insurance premiums for police officers who are
9 terminally ill.

10 Section 140. The sum of \$140,000, or so much thereof as may
11 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
12 the U.S. Marine Corps Scholarship Fund to provide grants for
13 scholarships for Higher Education.

14 Section 145. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may
15 be necessary, is appropriated from the SOS Federal Projects
16 Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for the payment
17 of any operational expenses relating to the cost incident to
18 augmenting the Illinois Commercial Motor Vehicle safety program
19 by assuring and verifying the identity of drivers prior to
20 licensure, including CDL operators; for improved security for
21 Drivers Licenses and Personal Identification Cards; and any
22 other related program deemed appropriate by the Office of the
23 Secretary of State.

1 Section 150. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
3 of State from the Securities Investors Education Fund for any
4 expenses used to promote public awareness of the dangers of
5 securities fraud.

6 Section 155. The sum of \$5,000, or so much thereof as may
7 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
8 of State from the Secretary of State Evidence Fund for the
9 purchase of evidence, for the employment of persons to obtain
10 evidence, and for the payment for any goods or services related
11 to obtaining evidence.

12 Section 160. The sum of \$225,000, or so much thereof as may
13 be necessary, is appropriated from the Alternate Fuels Fund to
14 the Office of Secretary of State for the cost of administering
15 the Alternate Fuels Act.

16 Section 165. The sum of \$16,000,000, or so much thereof as
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State
18 Special Services Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State
19 for office automation and technology.

20 Section 170. The sum of \$16,000,000, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Motor Vehicle
2 License Plate Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for
3 the cost incident to providing new or replacement plates for
4 motor vehicles.

5 Section 175. The sum of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State
7 DUI Administration Fund to the Office of Secretary of State for
8 operation of the Department of Administrative Hearings of the
9 Office of Secretary of State and for no other purpose.

10 Section 180. The sum of \$15,000, or so much thereof as may
11 be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State
12 Police DUI Fund to the Secretary of State for the payments of
13 goods and services that will assist in the prevention of
14 alcohol-related criminal violence throughout the State.

15 Section 185. The sum of \$700,000, or so much thereof as may
16 be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State
17 Police Services Fund to the Secretary of State for purposes as
18 indicated by the grantor or contractor or, in the case of money
19 bequeathed or granted for no specific purpose, for any purpose
20 as deemed appropriate by the Director of Police, Secretary of
21 State in administering the responsibilities of the Secretary
22 of State Department of Police.

1 Section 190. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as may
 2 be necessary, is appropriated from the Office of the Secretary
 3 of State Grant Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State to
 4 be expended in accordance with the terms and conditions upon
 5 which such funds were received.

6 Section 195. The sum of \$24,300, or so much thereof as may
 7 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
 8 of State from the State Library Fund to increase the collection
 9 of books, records, and holdings; to hold public forums; to
 10 purchase equipment and resource materials for the State
 11 Library; and for the upkeep, repair, and maintenance of the
 12 State Library building and grounds.

13 Section 200. The following sum, or so much thereof as may
 14 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
 15 of State for any operations, alterations, rehabilitations, new
 16 construction, and maintenance of the interior and exterior of
 17 the various buildings and facilities under the jurisdiction of
 18 the Secretary of State to enhance security measures in the
 19 Capitol Complex:

20 From General Revenue Fund4,000,000

21 Section 205. The sum of \$13,500,000, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of
2 State Identification Security and Theft Prevention Fund to the
3 Office of Secretary of State for all costs related to
4 implementing identification security and theft prevention
5 measures.

6 Section 210. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
7 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
8 of State from the Driver Services Administration Fund for the
9 payment of costs related to the issuance of temporary visitor's
10 driver's licenses, and other operational costs, including
11 personnel, facilities, computer programming, and data
12 transmission.

13 Section 215. The sum of \$2,200,000, or so much thereof as
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Monitoring Device
15 Driving Permit Administration Fee Fund to the Office of the
16 Secretary of State for all Secretary of State costs associated
17 with administering Monitoring Device Driving Permits per Public
18 Act 95-0400.

19 Section 220. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as
20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Indigent BAIID Fund
21 to the Office of the Secretary of State to reimburse ignition

1 interlock device providers per Public Act 95-0400, including
2 reimbursements submitted in prior years.

3 Section 225. The sum of \$75,000, or so much thereof as may
4 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
5 the Illinois Professional Golfers Association Junior Golf Fund
6 for grants to the Illinois Professional Golfers Association
7 Foundation to help Association members expose Illinois
8 youngsters to the game of golf.

9 Section 230. The sum of \$125,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
11 from the Agriculture in the Classroom Fund for grants to support
12 Agriculture in the Classroom programming for public and private
13 schools within Illinois.

14 Section 235. The sum of \$30,000, or so much thereof as may
15 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
16 the Boy Scout and Girl Scout Fund for grants to the Illinois
17 divisions of the Boy Scouts of America and the Girl Scouts of
18 the U.S.A.

19 Section 240. The sum of \$75,000, or so much thereof as may
20 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
21 the Support Our Troops Fund for grants to Illinois Support Our

1 Troops, Inc. for charitable assistance to the troops and their
2 families in accordance with its Articles of Incorporation.

3 Section 245. The sum of \$4,000, or so much thereof as may
4 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
5 of State from the Rotary Club Fund for grants for charitable
6 purposes sponsored by the Rotary Club.

7 Section 250. The sum of \$15,000, or so much thereof as may
8 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
9 of State from the Ovarian Cancer Awareness Fund for grants to
10 the National Ovarian Cancer Coalition, Inc. for ovarian cancer
11 research, education, screening, and treatment.

12 Section 255. The sum of \$6,000, or so much thereof as may
13 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
14 of State from the Sheet Metal Workers International Association
15 of Illinois Fund for grants for charitable purposes sponsored
16 by Illinois chapters of the Sheet Metal Workers International
17 Association.

18 Section 260. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as
19 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
20 of State from the Illinois Police Association Fund for
21 providing death benefits for the families of police officers

1 killed in the line of duty, and for providing scholarships, for
2 graduate study, undergraduate study, or both, to children and
3 spouses of police officers killed in the line of duty.

4 Section 265. The sum of \$5,000, or so much thereof as may
5 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
6 the International Brotherhood of Teamsters Fund for grants to
7 the Teamsters Joint Council 25 Charitable Trust for religious,
8 charitable, scientific, literary, and educational purposes.

9 Section 270. The sum of \$15,000, or so much thereof as may
10 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
11 of State from the Fraternal Order of Police Fund for grants to
12 the Illinois Fraternal Order of Police to increase the
13 efficiency and professionalism of law enforcement officers in
14 Illinois, to educate the public about law enforcement issues,
15 to more firmly establish the public confidence in law
16 enforcement, to create partnerships with the public, and to
17 honor the service of law enforcement officers.

18 Section 275. The sum of \$45,000, or so much thereof as may
19 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
20 the Share the Road Fund for grants to the League of Illinois
21 Bicyclists, a not for profit corporation, for educational
22 programs instructing bicyclists and motorists how to legally

1 and more safely share the roadways.

2 Section 280. The sum of \$3,500, or so much thereof as may
3 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
4 of State from the St. Jude Children's Research Fund for grants
5 to St. Jude Children's Research Hospital for pediatric
6 treatment and research.

7 Section 285. The sum of \$20,000, or so much thereof as may
8 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
9 of State from the Ducks Unlimited Fund for grants to Ducks
10 Unlimited, Inc. to fund wetland protection, enhancement, and
11 restoration projects in the State of Illinois, to fund
12 education and outreach for media, volunteers, members, and the
13 general public regarding waterfowl and wetlands conservation
14 in the State of Illinois, and to cover reasonable cost for
15 Ducks Unlimited plate advertising and administration of the
16 wetland conservation projects and education program.

17 Section 290. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as may
18 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
19 the Family Responsibility Fund for all costs associated with
20 enforcement of the Family Financial Responsibility Law.

21 Section 295. The sum of \$20,000, or so much thereof as may

1 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
2 of State from the Illinois State Police Memorial Park Fund for
3 grants to the Illinois State Police Heritage Foundation, Inc.
4 for building and maintaining a memorial and park, holding an
5 annual memorial commemoration, giving scholarships to children
6 of State police officers killed or catastrophically injured in
7 the line of duty, and providing financial assistance to police
8 officers and their families when a police officer is killed
9 or injured in the line of duty.

10 Section 300. The sum of \$1,000, or so much thereof as may
11 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
12 of State from the Illinois Sheriffs' Association Scholarship
13 and Training Fund for grants to the Illinois Sheriffs'
14 Association for scholarships obtained in a competitive process
15 to attend the Illinois Teen Institute or an accredited college
16 or university, for programs designed to benefit the elderly and
17 teens, and for law enforcement training.

18 Section 305. The sum of \$15,000, or so much thereof as may
19 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
20 of State from the Alzheimer's Awareness Fund for grants to the
21 Alzheimer's Disease and Related Disorders Association, Greater
22 Illinois Chapter, for Alzheimer's care, support, education, and
23 awareness programs.

1 Section 310. The sum of \$40,000, or so much thereof as may
2 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
3 of State from the Illinois Nurses Foundation Fund for grants
4 to the Illinois Nurses Foundation, to promote the health of the
5 public by advancing the nursing profession in this State.

6 Section 315. The sum of \$30,000, or so much thereof as may
7 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
8 of State from the Hospice Fund for grants to a statewide
9 organization whose primary membership consists of hospice
10 programs.

11 Section 320. The sum of \$50, or so much thereof as may be
12 necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary of
13 State from the Illinois Police Benevolent and Protective
14 Association Fund for grants to the Illinois Police Benevolent
15 and Protective Association for the purposes of providing death
16 benefits for the families of police officers killed in the line
17 of duty, providing scholarships for undergraduate study to
18 children and spouses of police officers killed in the line of
19 duty, and educating the public and police officers regarding
20 policing and public safety.

21 Section 325. The sum of \$550, or so much thereof as may

1 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
2 of State from the American Red Cross Fund for grants to the
3 American Red Cross or to charitable entities designated by the
4 American Red Cross.

5 Section 330. The sum of \$925, or so much thereof as may
6 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
7 of State from the Illinois Police K-9 Memorial Fund for grants
8 to the Northern Illinois K-9 Police Memorial for the creation,
9 operation and maintenance of a police K-9 memorial monument.

10 Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
11 2017.
