6 Whenever it becomes necessary for the State or any governmental unit to furnish in a disaster area emergency 7 services directly related to or required by a disaster and 8 existing funds are insufficient to provide such services, the 9 10 Governor may, when he considers such action in the best interest of the State, release funds from the General Revenue 11 12 disaster relief appropriation in order to provide such services or to reimburse local governmental bodies furnishing 13 such services. Such appropriation may be used for payment of 14 15 the Illinois National Guard when called to active duty in 16 case of disaster, and for the emergency purchase or renting 17 of equipment and commodities. Such appropriation shall be used for emergency services and relief to the disaster area 18 as a whole and shall not be used to provide private relief to 19 20 persons sustaining property damages or personal injury as a result of a disaster. 21

6 Section 50. The sum of \$316,220, or so much thereof as 7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation 8 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency 9 for the purpose of funding costs related to environmental 10 cleanup of the Ottawa Radiation Areas Superfund Project under 11 cooperative agreements with the Federal Government.

The sum of \$145,500, or so much thereof as 12 Section 55. may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation 13 14 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for recovery and remediation of radioactive materials and 15 16 contaminated facilities or properties when such expenses cannot be paid by a responsible person or an available 17 18 surety.

19 Section 60. The sum of \$373,450, or so much thereof as 20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation 21 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency 22 for local responder training, demonstrations, research, HB4354 -15- OMB096 00104 KML 10104 b 1 studies and investigations under funding agreements with the 2 Federal Government.

Section 65. The sum of \$97,000, or so much thereof as 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety 4 5 Emergency Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for related training and travel expenses 6 and to reimburse the Illinois State Police and the Illinois 7 Commerce Commission for costs incurred for activities related 8 9 to inspecting and escorting shipments of spent nuclear fuel, 10 high-level radioactive waste, and transuranic waste in Illinois as provided under the rules of the Agency. 11

Section 70. The sum of \$215,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Sheffield Agreed Order Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for the care, maintenance, monitoring, testing, remediation and insurance of the low-level radioactive waste disposal site near Sheffield, Illinois.

18 Section 75. The sum of \$583,940, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the 19 Low-Level Radioactive Waste Facility Development and Operation Fund to 20 21 the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for use in accordance with Section 14(a) of the Illinois Low-Level 22

The sum of \$180,000, or so much thereof as 3 Section 85. necessary, is appropriated from 4 be the Radiation may Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency 5 for costs and expenses related to or in support of a public 6 safety shared services center. 7

8 Section 85. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Emergency 10 Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Management Emergency Management Agency for costs and expenses related to or in 11 support of a public safety shared services center. 12

Section 90. The sum of \$558,372, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety Emergency Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for costs and expenses related to or in support of a public safety shared services center.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,2009.
