AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented 2 in the General Assembly: 3

Section 5. "AN ACT concerning appropriations", Public Act 4 103-6, approved with items reduced on June 7, 2023, is amended 5 by changing Sections 35 and 45 of Article 33 as follows: 6

7 Section 35. The following named amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the 8 State Comptroller to pay the elected State officers of the 9 10 Executive Branch of the State Government, at various rates prescribed by law: 11
