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A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes
7 hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the ordinary and
8 contingent expenses of the Illinois Criminal Justice
9 Information Authority:

11 Section 15. The sum of \$110,000,000, or so much thereof
 12 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal Justice
 13 Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information
 14 Authority for awards and grants to local units of government,
 15 state agencies and non-profit organizations.

16 Section 20. The following named sums, or so much thereof
 17 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois Criminal
 18 Justice Information Authority for activities undertaken in
 19 support of federal assistance programs administered by units
 20 of state and local government and non-profit organizations:

21 Payable from the Criminal Justice

1 Section 25. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
 2 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois Criminal
 3 Justice Information Authority for awards and grants and other
 4 monies received from federal agencies, from other units of
 5 government, and from private/not-for-profit organizations for
 6 activities undertaken in support of investigating issues in
 7 criminal justice and for undertaking other criminal justice
 8 information projects:

14 Section 30. The sum of \$7,800, or so much thereof as may
 15 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois State Crime
 16 Stoppers Association Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice
 17 Information Authority for grants to enhance and develop Crime
 18 Stoppers programs in Illinois.

19 Section 35. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
 20 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes
 21 hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Illinois Criminal
 22 Justice Information Authority for the training of law

1 enforcement personnel and services for families of homicide or
2 murder:

13 Section 40. The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as may
14 be necessary, is appropriated from the Prescription Pill and
15 Drug Disposal Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information
16 Authority for the purpose of collection, transportation, and
17 incineration of pharmaceuticals by local law enforcement
18 agencies.

19 Section 45. The following amounts, or so much thereof as
20 may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated for the
21 objects and purposes named, to meet the ordinary and contingent
22 expenses of the Illinois Criminal Justice Information
23 Authority:

16 Section 50. The sum of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof as
 17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
 18 to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for the
 19 purpose of awarding grants, contracts, administrative expenses
 20 and all related costs for the Safe From the Start Program.

21 Section 55. The amount of \$525,000, or so much thereof as
 22 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
 23 to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for the

1 Illinois Family Violence Coordinating Council Program.

2 Section 60. The amount of \$7,805,100, or so much thereof
3 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
4 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for
5 administrative costs, awards and grants for Community-Based
6 Violence Prevention Programs.

7 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1,
8 2018. Notwithstanding anything in this Act to the contrary,
9 appropriations authorized in this Act shall be used for all
10 costs incurred prior to July 1, 2019.
