Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

5	Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
6	as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated for the

20	Section 5. The sum of \$831,900, or so much thereof as may
21	be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to
22	the Office of the State Fire Marshal for costs and expenses
23	related to or in support of a public safety shared services
24	center.

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1	Section 10. The sum of \$65,000, or so much thereof as may
2	be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to
3	the Office of the State Fire Marshal for costs and expenses
4	related to or in support of the Fire Explorer and Cadet School.
5	Section 15. The sum of \$400,000, or so much thereof as may
6	be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Fire Fighters'
7	Memorial Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for
8	expenses related to the maintenance of the Illinois
9	Firefighters' Memorial, holding the annual Fallen Firefighter
10	Ceremony, and other expenses as allowed under Public Act 91-
11	0832.
12	Section 20. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
13	as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the
14	Office of the State Fire Marshal as follows:

4	Section 25. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
5	as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated for the

15	Section 30. The sum of \$1,000, or so much thereof as may
16	be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to
17	the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants available for
18	the development of new fire districts.
19	Section 35. The sum of \$125,000, or so much thereof as may
20	be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to
21	the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants available for
22	costs and services related to ILEAS/MABAS administration.

- Section 40. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as 1
- may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund 2
- to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for the maintenance and 3
- repair of the Illinois Fire Museum.
- Section 45. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as 5
- may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund 6
- 7 to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for deposit into the
- 8 Fire Truck Revolving Loan Fund.
- 9 Section 50. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as
- 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund
- to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants for the 11
- Small Equipment Grant Program. 12
- 13 Section 55. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as
- 14 may be necessary, is appropriation from the Fire Prevention
- Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for deposit into 15
- 16 the Fire Station Revolving Loan Fund.
- 17 Section 60. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may
- 18 be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to
- 19 the Office of the State Fire Marshal for a grant to the
- Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Reimbursement. 20

- 1 Section 65. The sum of \$550,000, or so much thereof as may
- 2 be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground Storage Tank
- 3 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for a grant to the
- 4 City of Chicago for administrative costs incurred as a result
- of the State's Underground Storage Program.
- 6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
- 7 2017, if and only if Senate Bill 2063 of the 100th General
- 8 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced
- 9 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
