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A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated for the
7 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of the State
8 Fire Marshal, as follows:

20 Section 5. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may
21 be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to
22 the Office of the State Fire Marshal for costs and expenses
23 related to or in support of a public safety shared services
24 center.

1 Section 10. The sum of \$65,000, or so much thereof as may
2 be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to
3 the Office of the State Fire Marshal for costs and expenses
4 related to or in support of the Fire Explorer and Cadet School.

5 Section 15. The sum of \$3,500,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund
7 to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants for the
8 Small Equipment Grant Program.

9 Section 20. The sum of \$360,000, or so much thereof as may
10 be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to
11 the Office of the State Fire Marshal for the purchase of Gross
12 Decontamination Buckets.

13 Section 25. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund
15 to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for all costs associated
16 with the Minimum Basic Firefighter Training Program.

17 Section 30. The sum of \$60,000, or so much thereof as may
18 be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to
19 the Office of the State Fire Marshal for all costs associated
20 with the Illinois Firefighter Peer Support Program.

1 Section 35. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may
 2 be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to
 3 the Office of the State Fire Marshal for all costs associated
 4 with the Community Risk Reduction Program.

5 Section 40. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as may
 6 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Fire Fighters'
 7 Memorial Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for
 8 expenses related to the maintenance of the Illinois
 9 Firefighters' Memorial, holding the annual Fallen Firefighter
 10 Ceremony, and other expenses as allowed under Public Act 91-
 11 0832.

12 Section 45. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
 13 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the
 14 Office of the State Fire Marshal as follows:

15 Payable from the Fire Prevention Fund:

16 For Expenses of Senior Officer Training55,000
 17 For Expenses of the Cornerstone Program350,000
 18 For Expenses related to Fire Fighter training
 19 Programs230,000
 20 For Expenses of Online Firefighter
 21 Certification Testing590,000

22 Payable from the Fire Prevention Division Fund:

1 For Expenses of the U.S. Resource
 2 Conservation and Recovery Act
 3 Underground Storage Program1,000,000

4 Section 50. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
 5 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated for the
 6 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of the State
 7 Fire Marshal, as follows:

8 GRANTS

9 Payable from the Fire Prevention Fund:

10 For Chicago Fire Department Training Program2,838,800
 11 For payment to local governmental agencies
 12 which participate in the State Training
 13 Programs950,000
 14 Total \$3,788,800

15 Section 55. The sum of \$500, or so much thereof as may be
 16 necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to the
 17 Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants available for the
 18 development of new fire districts.

19 Section 60. The sum of \$125,000, or so much thereof as may
 20 be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to
 21 the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants available for
 22 costs and services related to ILEAS/MABAS administration.

1 Section 65. The sum of \$10,000, or so much thereof as may
2 be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to
3 the Office of the State Fire Marshal for a grant to the
4 Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Reimbursement.

5 Section 70. The sum of \$550,000, or so much thereof as may
6 be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground Storage Tank
7 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for a grant to the
8 City of Chicago for administrative costs incurred as a result
9 of the State's Underground Storage Program.

10 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1,
11 2019.
