1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2390

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 2390 by deleting
3 everything after the enacting clause and replacing it with
4 the following:

5 "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 5. The amount of \$13,091,050, or so much thereof
7 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the
8 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
9 Representatives for furnishing the items provided in Section
10 4 of the General Assembly Compensation Act to members of
11 their respective houses throughout the year in connection
12 with their legislative duties and responsibilities and not in
13 connection with any political campaign as prescribed by law.
14 Of this amount, 37.436% is appropriated to the President of

1 the Senate for such expenditures and 62.564% is appropriated
2 to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures.

3 Section 10. Payments from the amounts appropriated in
4 Section 5 hereof shall be made only upon the delivery of a
5 voucher approved by the member to the State Comptroller. The
6 voucher shall also be approved by the President of the Senate
7 or the Speaker of the House of Representatives as the case
8 may be.

9 Section 15. The amount of \$20,338,646 or so much thereof
10 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to meet
11 the ordinary and incidental expenses of the Senate
12 legislative leadership and legislative staff assistants and
13 the House Majority and Minority leadership staff, general
14 staff and office operations. Of this amount, 24.73% is
15 appropriated to the President of the Senate for such
16 expenditures, 26.04% is appropriated to the Senate Minority
17 Leader for such expenditures and 25.12% is appropriated to
18 the Speaker of the House for such expenditures, and 24.11% is
19 appropriated to the House Minority Leader for such
20 expenditures.

21 Section 20. The amount of \$9,382,100, or so much thereof
22 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the

1 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
2 Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses of
3 committees, the general staff and operations, per diem
4 employees, special and standing committees, expenses incurred
5 in transcribing and printing of debates. Of this amount,
6 43.018% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for
7 such expenditures and 56.982% is appropriated to the Speaker
8 of the House for such expenditures.

9 Section 25. The amount of \$309,200, or so much thereof
10 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the
11 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
12 Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses,
13 also including the purchasing on contract as required by law
14 of printing, binding, printing paper, stationery and office
15 supplies. For the House, no part of which shall be expended
16 for expenses of purchasing, handling or distributing such
17 supplies and against which no indebtedness shall be incurred
18 without the written approval of the Speaker of the House of
19 Representatives. Of this amount, 69.277% is appropriated to
20 the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 30.723%
21 is appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such
22 expenditures.

23 Section 30. The amount of \$4,378,008, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the
2 President of the Senate for the use of standing committees
3 for expert witnesses, technical services, consulting
4 assistance and other research assistance associated with
5 special studies and long range research projects which may be
6 requested by the standing committees and the Speaker of the
7 House of Representatives for Standing House Committees
8 pursuant to the Legislative Commission Reorganization Act of
9 1984. Of this amount, 45.587% is appropriated to the
10 President of the Senate for such expenditures and 54.413% is
11 appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such
12 expenditures.

13 Section 35. The amount of \$162,825, or so much thereof
14 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the
15 President of the Senate and the Senate Minority Leader for
16 allowances for the particular and additional services
17 appertaining to or entailed by the respective officers of the
18 Senate. Of this amount, 48.7% is appropriated to the
19 President of the Senate for such expenditures and 51.3% is
20 appropriated to the Senate Minority Leader for such
21 expenditures.

22 Section 40. The amount of \$88,100, or so much thereof as
23 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the

1 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
2 Representatives for travel, including expenses to Springfield
3 of members on official legislative business during weeks when
4 the General Assembly is not in session. Of this amount,
5 65.5% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such
6 expenditures and 34.5% is appropriated to the Speaker of the
7 House for such expenditures.

8 Section 45. The amount of \$441,600, or so much thereof
9 as may be necessary and remains unexpended from an
10 appropriation heretofore made for such purposes in Article
11 70, Section 45 of Public Act 96-956, is appropriated to the
12 Speaker of the House for expenses in connection with the
13 planning and preparation of redistricting of legislative and
14 representative districts as required by Article IV, Section 3
15 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970.

16 Section 50. The amount of \$341,600, or so much thereof
17 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
18 Fund to the General Assembly to meet ordinary and contingent
19 expenses. Any use of funds appropriated under this Section
20 must be approved jointly by the Clerk of the House of
21 Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate.

22 Section 55. As used in Section 15 hereof, except where

1 the approval of the Speaker of the House of Representatives
2 is expressively required for the expenditure of or the
3 incurring of indebtedness against an appropriation for
4 certain purchases on contract, "Speaker" means the leader of
5 the party having the largest number of members of the House
6 of Representatives as of January 14, 2009, and "Minority
7 Leader" means the leader of the party having the second
8 largest number of members of the House of Representatives as
9 of January 14, 2009.

10 Section 60. The sum of \$113,700, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated for the ordinary and
12 contingent expenses of the Senate Operations Commission
13 including the planning costs, construction costs, moving
14 expenses and all other costs associated with the construction
15 and reconstruction of Senate offices in the Capitol Complex
16 area.

17 Section 65. The amount of \$750,000, or so much thereof
18 as may be necessary and remains unexpended from an
19 appropriation heretofore made for such purposes in Article
20 70, Section 70 of Public Act 96-956, is appropriated to the
21 President of the Senate for expenses in connection with the
22 planning and preparation of redistricting of legislative and
23 representative districts as required by Article IV, Section 3

1 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970.

2 Section 70. The amount of \$750,000, or so much thereof
3 as may be necessary and remains unexpended from an
4 appropriation heretofore made for such purposes in Article
5 70, Section 70 of Public Act 96-956, is appropriated to the
6 Minority Leader of the Senate for expenses in connection with
7 the planning and preparation of redistricting of legislative
8 and representative districts as required by Article IV,
9 Section 3 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970.

10 Section 75. The amount of \$750,000, or so much thereof
11 as may be necessary and remains unexpended from an
12 appropriation heretofore made for such purposes in Article
13 70, Section 75 of Public Act 96-956, is appropriated to the
14 Speaker of the House of Representatives for expenses in
15 connection with the planning and preparation of redistricting
16 of legislative and representative districts as required by
17 Article IV, Section 3 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970.

18 Section 80 The amount of \$750,000, or so much thereof as
19 may be necessary and remains unexpended from an appropriation
20 heretofore made for such purposes in Article 70, Section 75
21 of Public Act 96-956, is appropriated to the Minority Speaker
22 of the House of Representatives for expenses in connection

1 with the planning and preparation of redistricting of
2 legislative and representative districts as required by
3 Article IV, Section 3 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970.

4 Section 85. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated from the
6 General Assembly Operations Revolving Fund to the President
7 of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives
8 to meet ordinary and contingent expenses. Of this amount,
9 50% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such
10 expenditures and 50% is appropriated to the Speaker of the
11 House for such expenditures.

12 ARTICLE 2

13 Section 5. The amount of \$3,932,900, or so much thereof
14 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
15 Fund to the Commission on Government Forecasting and
16 Accountability to meet its operational expenses for the
17 fiscal year ending June 30, 2012.

18 ARTICLE 3

19 Section 5. The amount of \$2,160,000, or so much thereof
20 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue

1 Fund to the Legislative Printing Unit to meet its operational
2 expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012.

3 ARTICLE 4

4 Section 5. The amount of \$233,500, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
6 Fund to the Legislative Audit Commission to meet its
7 operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30,
8 2012.

9 ARTICLE 5

10 Section 5. The amount of \$2,930,950, or so much thereof
11 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
12 Fund to the Legislative Research Unit to meet its operational
13 expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012.

14 ARTICLE 6

15 Section 5. The amount of \$2,489,400, or so much thereof
16 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
17 Fund to the Legislative Reference Bureau to meet its
18 operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30,
19 2012.

Section 5. The amount of \$5,166,700, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Legislative Information System to meet its operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012.

Section 10. The following amount, or so much of that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Assembly Computer Equipment Revolving Fund to the Legislative Information System:

ARTICLE 9

2

Section 60. The sum of \$312,455, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Legislative Ethics
4 Commission to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of
5 the Commission and the Office of Legislative Inspector
6 General.

Section 5. The amount of \$1,669,500, or so much thereof
9 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
10 Fund to the Architect of the Capitol to meet its operational
11 expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July
13 1, 2011."
