

SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Engrossed House Bill 1169 be amended to read as follows:

1	Page 16, between lines 16 and 17, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2	"SECTION 41. IC 16-41-2-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.112-2020,
3	SECTION 13, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4	UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 1. (a) The state department may adopt rules
5	under IC 4-22-2, including emergency rules under IC 4-22-2-37.1, that
6	establish reporting, monitoring, and preventive procedures for
7	communicable diseases.
8	(b) The state department shall publish a list of:
9	(1) reportable communicable diseases;
10	(2) other diseases or conditions that pose a serious health risk
11	based upon the characteristics of the disease or condition; and
12	(3) the control measures for the diseases and conditions;
13	on the state department's Internet web site. The state department is not
14	required to adopt rules under subsection (a) for the list described in this
15	subsection.
16	(c) Notwithstanding subsection (a) or (b), the state department
17	may make recommendations to governmental entities relating to
18	COVID-19 (as defined in IC 16-28-11-8). However, nothing in this
19	section shall be construed to:
20	(1) require a governmental entity to adopt the recommended
21	reporting, monitoring, or preventive procedures for
22	COVID-19 (as defined in IC 16-28-11-8);
23	(2) give the state department authority to enforce subsection
24	(a) or (b) in relation to COVID-19 (as defined in
25	IC 16-28-11-8); or
26	(3) limit the authority of the state department to adopt and

1 enforce rules that establish recommended reporting, 2 monitoring, and preventive procedures for COVID-19 (as 3 defined in IC 16-28-11-8) during a disaster emergency 4 declared under IC 10-14-3-12. 5 (c) (d) In updating the list described in subsection (b), the state 6 department: 7 (1) shall consider recommendations from: 8 (A) the United States Centers for Disease Control and 9 Prevention: and 10 (B) the Council of State and Territorial Epidemiologists; and 11 (2) may consult with local health departments. 12 SECTION 42. IC 16-41-2-1.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA 13 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS 14 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 1.5. (a) Notwithstanding 15 section 1 of this chapter, the state department may adopt rules 16 under IC 4-22-2 that establish recommended reporting, 17 monitoring, and preventive procedures for COVID-19 (as defined 18 in IC 16-28-11-8). 19 (b) The state department shall publish a list of recommended 20 control measures for COVID-19 (as defined in IC 16-28-11-8). 21 (c) Nothing in this section shall be construed to: 22 (1) require a governmental entity to adopt the recommended 23 reporting, monitoring, or preventive procedures for 24 COVID-19 (as defined in IC 16-28-11-8); 25 (2) give the state department authority to enforce subsection 26 (a) or (b) in relation to COVID-19 (as defined in 27 IC 16-28-11-8); or 28 (3) limit the authority of the state department to adopt and 29 enforce rules that establish recommended reporting, 30 monitoring, and preventive procedures for COVID-19 (as 31 defined in IC 16-28-11-8) during a disaster emergency 32 declared under IC 10-14-3-12.". 33 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
