

# PROPOSED AMENDMENT

## HB 1264 # 11

### DIGEST

Citizenship. Removes provisions from the bill that establish a process that must be followed if evidence exists that a registered voter is not a citizen of the United States. Removes a requirement that the state provide a county voter registration office with certain information if a voter has been disqualified or potentially disqualified as a prospective juror because of citizenship status. Urges assignment of an interim study committee topic.

- 16 **(b) This SECTION expires July 1, 2024.**
- 17 **SECTION 33. An emergency is declared for this act."**
