DIGEST

Group prescription drug rebates. Requires an insurer to do one of the following: (1) Apply 100% of the rebates to reduce premiums for all covered individuals equally. (2) Calculate defined cost sharing for a covered individual at the point of sale based on the price that is reduced by an amount equal to at least 85% of all rebates received by the insurer concerning the dispensing or administration of the covered individual's prescription drugs. Repeals a provision allowing an insurer to provide plan sponsors the option of calculating defined cost sharing for covered individuals of the plan sponsor at the point of sale. Makes corresponding change to the provision concerning the disclosure of certain information by an insurer to a plan sponsor.

16	2024]. See. 9. At the time of contracting, an insurer shall provide plan
17	sponsors the option of calculating defined cost sharing for covered
18	individuals of the plan sponsor at the point of sale based on a price that
19	is reduced by some or all of the rebates received or estimated to be
20	received by the insurer concerning the dispensing or administration of
21	the prescription drug.

23	SECTION 3, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE

1	JULY 1, 2024]: Sec. 11. An insurer shall disclose the following
2	information to a plan sponsor on at least an annual basis:
3	(1) The approximate amount of rebates expected to be received by
4	the insurer concerning the dispensing or administration of
5	prescription drugs to the covered individuals of the plan sponsor.
6	(2) An explanation that the plan sponsor may choose to: insurer
7	is either:
8	(A) apply the rebates to reduce premiums for all covered
9	individuals; or
10	(B) calculate defined cost sharing for a covered individual at
11	the point of sale based on a price that is reduced by rebates
12	received or estimated to be received by the insurer concerning
13	the dispensing or administration of the covered individual's
14	prescription drugs.
15	(A) using the rebates to reduce plan premiums, and
16	identify by how much; or
17	(B) calculating defined cost sharing for a covered
18	individual at the point of sale based on a price that is
19	reduced by rebates received by the insurer concerning the
20	dispensing or administration of the covered individual's
21	prescription drugs.
22	(3) An explanation that, in the individual market, IC 27-1-49
23	requires that covered individual defined cost sharing be calculated
24	at the point of sale based on a price that is reduced by at least
25	eighty-five percent (85%) of the rebates concerning the
26	dispensing or administration of the covered individual's
27	prescription drugs.".
