DIGEST

Group prescription drug rebates. Requires that an insurer offer to plan sponsors the following plans: (1) A plan that applies 100% of the rebates to reduce premiums for all covered individuals equally. (2) A plan that calculates defined cost sharing for covered individuals of the plan sponsor at the point of sale based on a price that is reduced by an amount equal to at least 85% of all of the rebates received or estimated to be received by the insurer concerning the dispensing or administration of the prescription drug. Allows a plan sponsor to choose one of the offered plans. Makes a corresponding change to a provision concerning the disclosure of certain information by an insurer to a plan sponsor.

IC 27-1-50-11, AS ADDED BY P.L.166-2023, 6 SECTION 3, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE 7 JULY 1, 2024]: Sec. 11. An insurer shall disclose the following 8 information to a plan sponsor on at least an annual basis: 9 (1) The approximate amount of rebates expected to be received by 10 the insurer concerning the dispensing or administration of 11 prescription drugs to the covered individuals of the plan sponsor. 12 (2) An explanation that the plan sponsor may choose to: 13 (A) apply the rebates to reduce premiums for all covered 14 individuals; or 15 (B) calculate defined cost sharing for a covered individual at 16 the point of sale based on a price that is reduced by an 17 amount equal to at least eighty-five percent (85%) of all 18 rebates received or estimated to be received by the insurer 19 concerning the dispensing or administration of the covered 20 individual's prescription drugs. (3) An explanation that, in the individual market, IC 27-1-49 21 22 requires that covered individual defined cost sharing be calculated 23 at the point of sale based on a price that is reduced by at least 24 eighty-five percent (85%) of the rebates concerning the 25 dispensing or administration of the covered individual's 26 prescription drugs.". 27 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
