## HOUSE MOTION

## MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1332 be amended to read as follows:

1	Page 17, between lines 39 and 40, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2	"SECTION 8. IC 27-1-25.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
3	AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4	JULY 1, 2024]:
5	Chapter 25.5. Fiduciary Duties
6	Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "employee benefit consultant"
7	means a person who:
8	(1) advises a plan sponsor about; and
9	(2) assists a plan sponsor in establishing and administering;
10	employee benefit programs.
11	Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "health insurance coverage"
12	includes:
13	(1) a group policy of accident and sickness insurance (as
14	defined in IC 27-8-5-1);
15	(2) a group contract (as defined in IC 27-13-1-16) that
16	provides coverage for basic health care services (as defined in
17	IC 27-13-1-4); and
18	(3) any other group health plan that limits eligibility to
19	members of a specific group.
20	The term includes coverage of a dependent of the covered
21	individual under a group policy or contract described in
22	subdivisions (1) through (3).

1	Sec. 3. As used in this chapter, "insurance producer" has the
2	meaning set forth in IC 27-1-15.6-2(9).
3	Sec. 4. As used in this chapter, "insurer" means an insurer that
4	provides health insurance coverage to a covered individual.
5	Sec. 5. As used in this chapter, "pharmacy benefit manager" has
6	the meaning set forth in IC 27-1-24.5-12.
7	Sec. 6. As used in this chapter, "plan sponsor" means an
8	employer or organization that offers health insurance coverage to
9	its employees or members through an insurer or a self-funded
10	health benefit plan.
11	Sec. 7. Any:
12	(1) third party administrator;
13	(2) pharmacy benefit manager;
14	(3) employee benefit consultant; or
15	(4) insurance producer;
16	acting on behalf of a plan sponsor owes a fiduciary duty to the plan
17	sponsor.".
18	Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
